## **Directions to Signal Point (PJ2T)**

If you have Google Maps on your SmartPhone you can type in "Villa Agave Curacao" or "The Sea Glass House Curacao" and get voiced directions also. These are two house rentals very near the station.

## From the Airport

As you exit the airport, take a right onto the roadway and continue for about a mile (1.5 KM) to the first round-about.

Take the first right off the round-about toward Tera Kora, the silver iguana statue's head in the center of the round-about points to the correct road. Note this round-about is two lanes wide, but poorly marked, so hold the outer right most line as you enter.



You will travel for several miles to the small town of Tera Kora with its many serious speed bumps. Slow down, enjoy the town center, but keep going. You'll see wind turbines off to your right.

Leaving Tera Kora you will see a modest gas station on the left, this is just an indication that you're on the right path. Continue on.

In about 2 miles (3 km) or a bit more start looking for a blue sign that announces a weird 45 degree angle LEFT turn to SOTO. Take it! The sign for Soto is quite close to the turn so look sharp.



Continue to the town of Soto. It is at least 5.5 miles (9 km). Entering Soto you'll go over three significant speed bumps, IMMEDIATELY after the last speed bump take a LEFT away from the church. This left has a very low (6 inch) brick lane divider. As you turn left you should see a red building advertising Amstel beer in big letters to the right and a green school complex to your left. You'll pass the historic, yellow "Landhaus Santa Marta" on your right.



You're in the country now! Follow this road over hill and dale for about 2 miles (4km) and at times along Santa Marta Bay. You will finally come to a speed bump (first of several) by a cell phone tower that is on your left. Keep going past a row of white condo buildings on your right and over more speed bumps.

The road will turn hard right and downhill just past a blue house on the right and a big white house on the left, the road narrows. As you go downhill you'll see yellow gutted buildings. This is "Sunset Waters", an abandoned resort. You are .6 miles (1 km) from your destination now. At the bottom of the hill, past all the colorful bougainvillea bushes, and over yet another speed bump take a hard left turn in front the small round-about. This is a very sharp left onto an even narrower road.



You'll pass yet more yellow wrecked buildings ... just go slowly. You're heading east and in several hundred yards (0.5 KM) you'll see the antennas/towers of Signal Point directly in front of you. You can park on the dirt driveway alongside the white wall. You'll find a gate thru the wall at the end of the dirt driveway down toward the sea.

N.B. If you are part of a large team also renting the "Moran House" it is locate past Signal Point and up the hill four more houses at #5.
