Dear Mr. De Canha,

In response to an email from Ms. C.I.M. Sandries (see reference above) I am resubmitting my request for the allocation of a special Amateur Radio callsign for Curacao.

I, Ronald Lodewyck (N6EE) and Mr. Chet Jensen (W6XK) are two Radio amateurs licensed in the USA who plan to be in Curacao from 1st January through to 10th January 2012. We are with the Caribbean Contesting Consortium and will be operating at #1 Groot St Marta. During our entire stay we plan to operate using the callsigns PJ2/W6XK and PJ2/N6EE. We also plan to compete in the ARRL RTTY Roundup contest which takes place on the weekend of 7th / 8th January and would like to use a special call for that event. We would like the callsign **PJ2N** if this is possible. The contest starts at 1800 UTC Saturday January 7 and ends at 2359 UTC Sunday January 8.

Mr. Jensen and I have each completed a License Application form and attached them along with a copy of each of our USA FCC License documents (Extra Class W6XK and Extra Class N6EE, respectively). A separate application requesting the special callsign PJ2N is also attached. I have remitted \$67 to cover the cost of assigning a special event call (\$58), plus \$9 for the stamp charges. Please note that Mr. Geoff Howard has paid this fee for us by MCB bank transfer.
